Sister Philip Marie Burle, C.P.P.S. is member of the Most Precious Blood Community in St. Louis, Missouri. She holds a B.A. from Fontbonne University in St. Louis, an M.E. in Counseling and Guidance from St. Louis University and a Doctor of Ministry Degree from FIC University in California. She holds a Certificate from the Institute of Religious Formation Program for Facilitators in Spiritual Direction Formation, and Renewal from St. Louis University. She also received training in the program for Spiritual Directors and Retreat Masters at the Jesuit Guelph Center of Spirituality in Canada.

Sister Philip Marie co-authored the "You Will Receive Power" program, which integrates the healing forces of Catholic tradition, scripture, sacraments, personal, and communal prayer. This program has been enthusiastically endorsed by Pope John Paul II, several Cardinals, many Bishops, and clergy all over the world.

Sister Philip Marie has also authored the book, "Praying the Scriptures of the Rosary and Way of the Cross" which has been distributed worldwide. (Mother Teresa, M.C. had distributed over 70,000 of the Rosary books to encourage prayer for healing of the family.) She has traveled to seven continents to speak at retreats and major conferences. Included among the geographies are 62 states and countries. She has taught in the Retreats International Program at Notre Dame University and has been featured on television in the United States: Mother Angelica LIVE with EWTN in Birmingham, AL and various Archdioceses, Japan, the Philippines, Zambia and featured on The Armed Forces Worldwide Television Network.
