Sister is a well known speaker, teacher and author. Sister Philip Marie Burle, C.P.P.S. is a member of the Most Precious Blood Community in O’Fallon, Missouri. She holds a B.A. from Fontbonne University in St. Louis, an M.E. in Counseling and Guidance from St. Louis University and a Doctor of Ministry Degree from FIC University in California. She holds a Certificate from the Institute of Religious Formation Program for Facilitators in Spiritual Direction, Formation, and Renewal from St. Louis University. She also received training in the program for Spiritual Directors and Retreat Masters at the Jesuit Guelph Center of Spirituality in Canada.

Sister Philip Marie coauthored the “You Will Receive Power” program, which integrates the healing forces of Catholic tradition, scripture, sacraments, personal, and communal prayer. The book, “Praying the Scriptures of the Rosary and Way of the Cross” has been distributed worldwide. (Blessed Mother Teresa, M.C. had distributed over 70,000 of the Rosary books to encourage prayer for healing of the family.)

Sister Philip Marie has also authored the book and CD “Praying the Scriptures of the Rosary of Mysteries of Light and Parallel Sacraments”.

This wonderful evening, in the Lord of Prayerful Thanksgiving and Reflection, will be a teaching on the last 8 Healing Prayers of Jesus from His Holy Cross.
